#### Bible Verse of the Month



42 Jesus said ..., "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I have come here from God. I have not come on my own; God sent me. 43 Why is my language not clear to you? Because you are unable to hear what I say. 44 You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies. 45 Yet because I tell the truth, you do not believe


me! 46 Can any of you prove me guilty of sin? If I am telling the truth, why don't you believe me? 47 Whoever belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God." - **John 8:42-47** 

1 What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? 2 You desire but do not have, so you kill. You covet but you cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight. You do not have because you do not ask God. 3 When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

4 You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity against God? Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. 5 Or do you think Scripture says without reason that he jealously longs for the spirit he has caused to dwell in us? 6 But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says:

"God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble."

7 Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. 8 Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. 9 Grieve, mourn and wail. Change your laughter to mourning and your joy to gloom. 10 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up. - James 4:1-10

#### GODFREY CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING

Friday, March 15, 2024

**Members in Attendance:** Bob Ridenour, Ferne Ridenour, Rose Mary Oglesby, Susan Wright, Sue Orban & Jamie Orban

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Susan Wright. Scripture was read by Bob Ridenour: Psalm 146:1-2. The meeting was called to order at 4:33 p.m. Minutes of the Sunday, March 15, 2024 meeting were reviewed by the council. A motion to accept the minutes as

written was made by Rose Mary Oglesby, seconded by Susan Wright. Motion carried.

#### **COMMITTEES:**

FINANCE: Chair Ferne Ridenour reported the following amounts as of March 2024:

**Reuter Trust:** \$263,327.18 (up \$3,208.01) as of 4/3/24. We received \$2,498.65 income from the trust on April 1, 2024. [The principal of the Reuter Trust Fund cannot be used until November 14, 2038.]

**Line of Credit:** \$4,500.00 (as of March, 2024)

**Building Repair Fund:** \$105.00 [This fund can only be spent on large building, grounds, and/or equipment repair or replacement costs, as approved by the Church Council.]

Total expenses for the month of March were \$2,818.06 and our total income was \$3,430.00. Income exceeded expenses by a total of \$611.94.

**FACILITIES & SUPPLIES:** Rose Mary Oglesby would like to extend a big thank you to Bruce Orban for bringing his tractor and wagon to church on March 16, 2024. Sue Orban and Rose Mary helped Bruce pick up the limbs and sticks from the church yard. Bruce trimmed the low hanging branches on the trees and all was taken back to the brush pile.

PERSONNEL & NOMINATING: No report at this time.

CHURCH GROWTH & NURTURE: Susan Wright reported the following: We mailed out ten cards to our church family and friends: four birthday, four Easter cards, one for an anniversary, and one get well card. The board had a survey meeting with all the members in March to approve purchasing Easter lilies and palms. The Growth and Nurture board will continue to prepare communion for any Sunday required.

CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT: Susan Wright reported that the average adult Christian Education attendance was 0 and the average attendance for our children's classes was 1. Sunday School Bible Study was not held and will not be held unless someone shows an interest in attending. Jolene and Susan discussed the Easter Story of Jesus from Easter books and a cartoon DVD we watched about His last week of life, an resurrection. Jolene finished decorating the shamrocks and a cross for Jesus to put in the fellowship hall for decoration.

**PASTOR'S REPORT:** No report at this time.

**DEACONESS:** No report at this time.

ACA REPORT: Susan Wright reported that the American Christian Academy is doing well. They are working on designing their sign and figuring out how to do it.

The ACA reported the following accomplishments: We had a wonderful Easter party on April 8 when we returned to school. We played a Bible game and watched a Jesus movie about His life with lots of candy, snacks, and a special buffet for lunch; In the last 90 days, ACA had reached 327 reaches on Facebook, 103 followers, 166 engaged, and 67 published content; and our field trip has been planned for May 20 to the St. Louis Zoo.
